Grief swept over Mwendamwalimwa, but even as the kingdom mourned, a storm brewed. Power struggles erupted among Lupola's closest

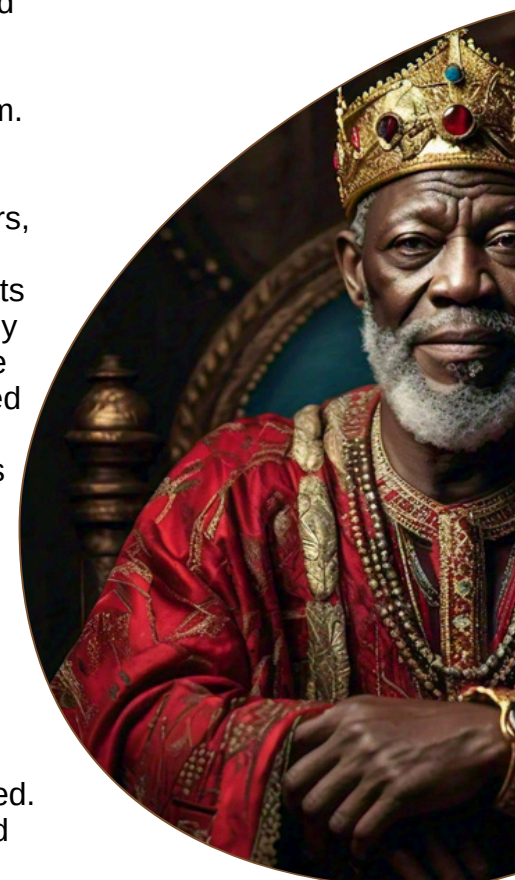
allies. His nephew, Kilometer Sampa, awaited the throne with bated breath, only for the council to rebuff him.

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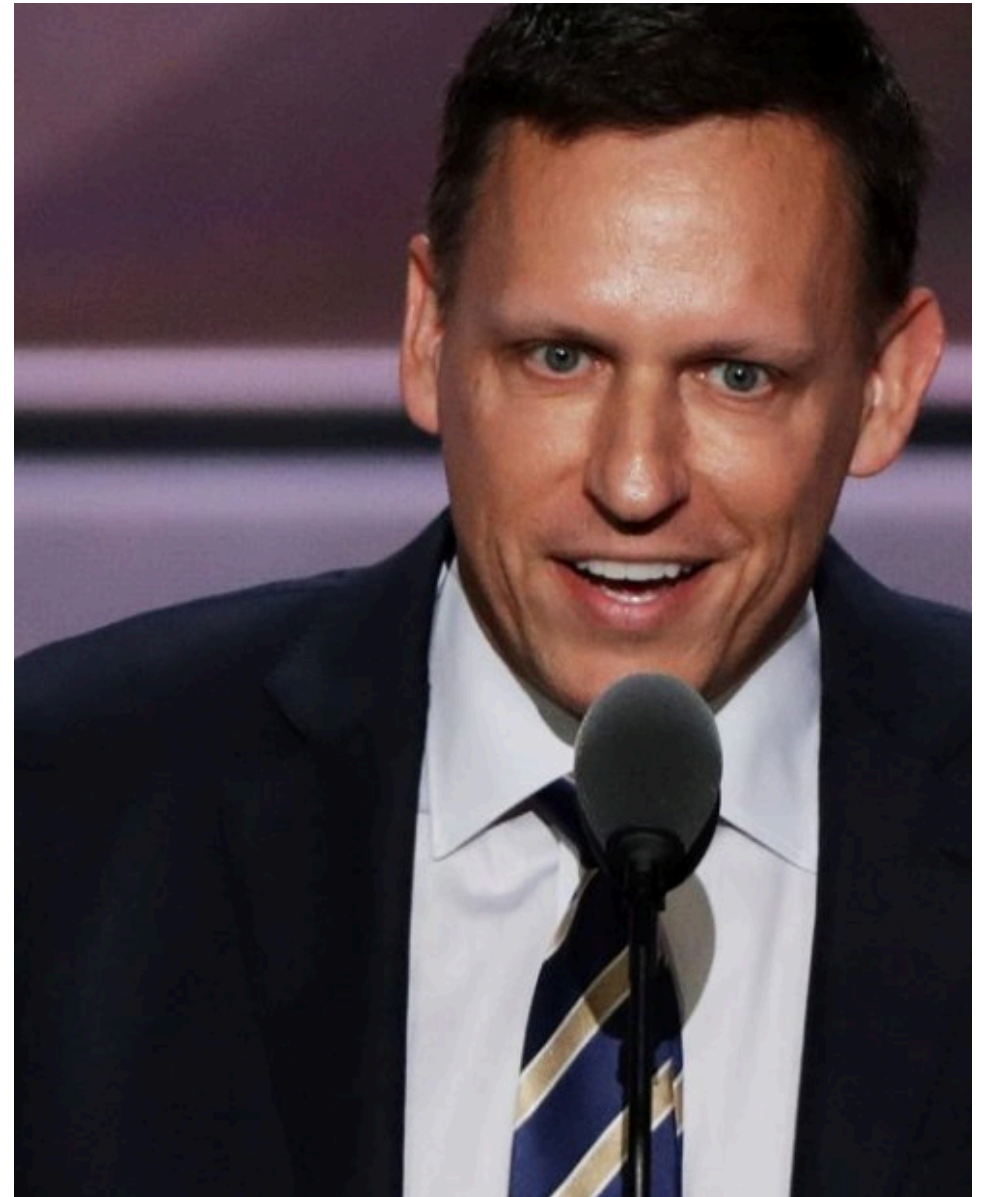
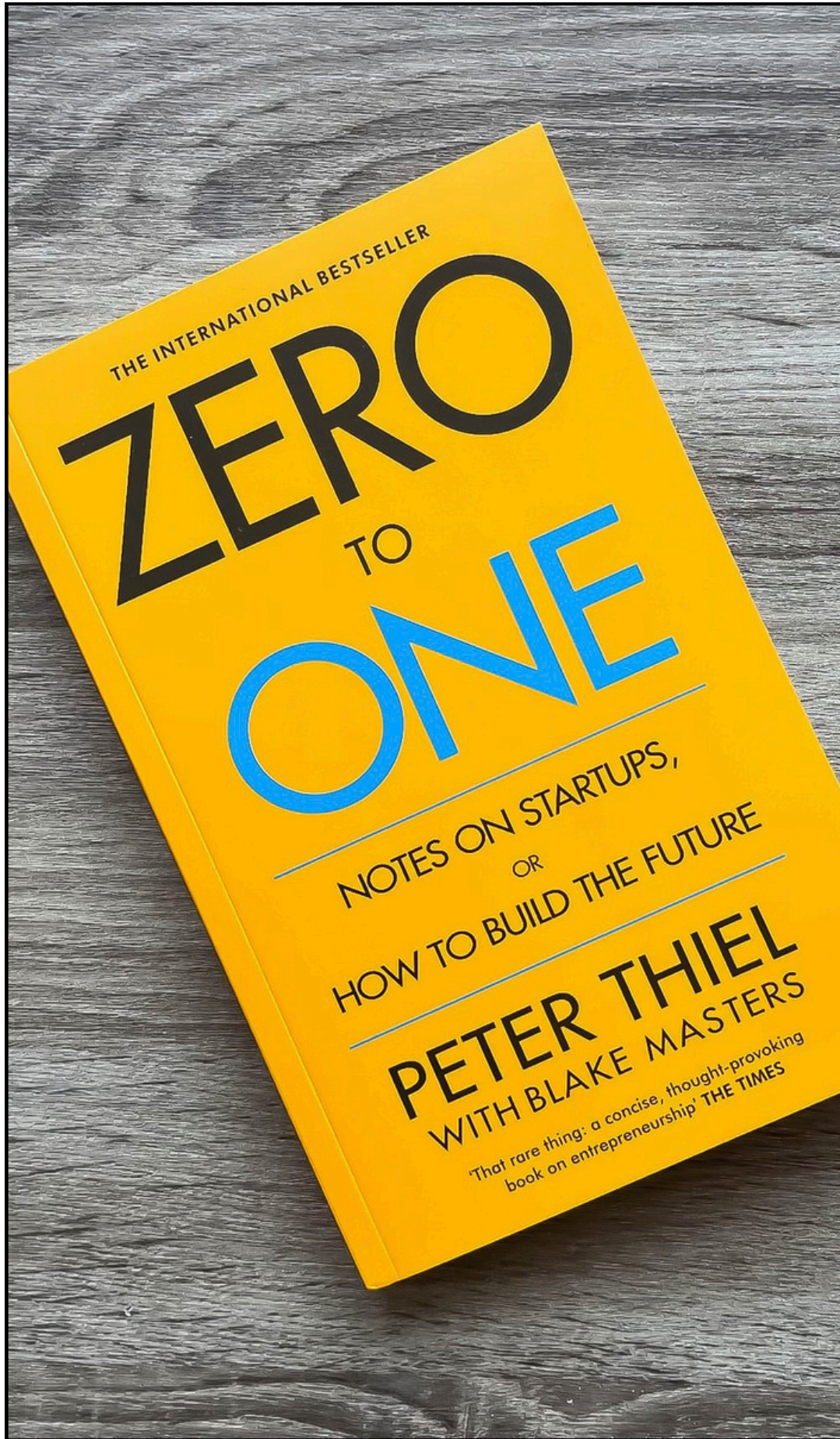

MIXED MARTIAL ARTS ATHLETE MIRACLE CHIPITO GEARS UP FOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP



Zambia Mixed Martial Arts athlete Miracle Chipito has called for financial support from the corporate world and well-wishers ahead of participation in the upcoming World Championships in Uzbekistan.

Chipito is among six athletes who have been lined up to compete in the World Mixed Martial Arts Championships in Uzbekistan this November from 3rd to 10th.

MMA Zambia reveals that it is currently seeking to raise \$15,000 in order to cover travel, accommodation, and other essential costs.

Chipito, a silver medalist at the Africa Championship in the flyweight category, has been hard at work training as she is currently working on her final movement drills as well as striking and wrestling in readiness for the fight.

“Preparation is going well for the World Championships. We’re working on specific movement drills, and I’m honing my striking and wrestling,” she said.

“The main challenges we’re facing at the moment are financial; we’re looking for sponsors to help us achieve our dreams of attending the championships.”

She, however, has disclosed that she and her fellow athletes are still falling short on financial and logistical support for the upcoming championship.

Chipito says she is ready for the championship, setting her sights on clinching a gold medal at the global event.

“The assistance we’re seeking is sponsorship or donations from well-wishers. We’re looking for sponsors or brands to get behind us, and then we will take their brands to the millions of people who follow mixed martial arts in Zambia and worldwide,” Chipito said.

“My ambition for the upcoming championships is to get gold and shock the world. I want to put Zambia on the map, and people are going to know where Zambia is and that women fighters from Zambia are some of the best in the world.”

MMA Zambia athletes earmarked to compete at the World Championships include Gilbert Ndlovu, a gold medalist at the Africa Championship in the middleweight category; Abraham Banda, who won a silver medalist at the Africa Championship in the bantamweight class; female bronze medalist at the Africa
